Core Competencies	Sub- Competencies	Definition
Frontier Spirit	Challenging Spirit	Attitude to respond to the difficulties encountered in reality in order to achieve his/her goals of life
	Future Insights	Ability to grasp and predict the future based on both past and current experiences and knowledge
	Self-developm ent	an attitude of making continuous efforts to compensate for one's shortcomings based on objective self-awareness
	Responsibility	The attitude to accomplish a given task or task while maintaining a high level of quality within a set time limit
	Achievement	Set goals at a relatively high level and strive to achieve them
Sharing and Collaboration	Empathy	Ability to understand and accommodate the viewpoint of others by looking at their situation and circumstances
	Social Engagement	Having the cooperative spirit and attitude to solve problems through proactivity and clear understanding of the problem
	Ethics	The attitude of advising others to comply with the regulations or guidelines set forth and to comply with them
	Consideration	The attitude of trying to understand and support the other person's difficulties or problems without pursuing only one's own comfort
	Teamwork	Ability to keep the atmosphere of your team smooth and to help team members who have difficulty adapting smoothly
Pragmatic Practice	Problem Solving	Ability to adaptively, efficiently, and functionally deal with a situation in question
	Basic major	The attitude of faithfully learning basic major knowledge
	competency	encountered through major subjects
	Professionalism	Ability to demonstrate professionalism and excellence in workmanship in some areas above a level that ordinary people can achieve
	Presenting ability	The ability to present to the other party in a concise and clear manner, and to logically persuade the other party if necessary
	Informational thinking	The ability to use a variety of media to obtain information with an interest in the information that has recently been mentioned as important
Creative Convergence	Analytical thinking	The ability to divide a particular phenomenon into simple parts and find a structure
	Creativity	Not adhering to stereotypes, creating new ideas, and the ability to apply ideas and concepts through fusion over a wide variety of disciplines
	Convergence of knowledge	The ability to connect knowledge in different fields to achieve a particular purpose
	Originality	Ability to approach the status quo in a new way, rather than in the old way, to create alternatives that were not previously seen
	Critical thinking	Ability to sensitively identify problems with phenomena or ideas and raise logical objections to them



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Global Leadership	Global Communication	Ability to eliminate prejudice against people from other cultural backgrounds and develop one's own multifaceted viewpoint
	Global Mind	Ability to view the world from a wide range of perspectives, without prejudice against other cultures
	Foreign language Capabilities	The ability to communicate smoothly in foreign languages and to write and read simple texts
	International exchange	An attitude to directly or indirectly experience the professional activities of foreign enterprises, international cultural events, etc
	Understanding Cultural Relativity	An attitude of understanding and accepting cultural specificity without rejecting heterogeneous cultures
